Texas Virtual School Network Offers Virtual Classes, for 9th-12th grade Students at La Joya I.S.D. for the 2010-2011 School Year

- High school students get connected today to a new path of opportunity to earn your credits towards graduation.
- **Current** 9th- 12th grade students will have an opportunity to take online courses to advance or to recover credits towards graduation.

Students interested in the virtual classes will need to take an online free READI test with their counselor to verify that they are good candidates for online virtual classes before they are officially registered for the class.

The virtual classes are rigorous.

- Students may enroll in up to two TXVSN courses for fall 2010. Students will have access to a lab, necessary books and supplies, and assistance from a Lab Proctor to complete their coursework.
- The course fee will be provided by the Texas Education Agency.
- In order to take courses, students must be enrolled in a Texas high school during the 2010-2011 school year, and meet eligibility requirements for continued enrollment in a Texas high school.

- Fall enrollment is now open.
